### **Interesting places nearby**



#### Havana Malecon

It was built in different periods during the 20th century, from 1901 to 1958. It started on La Punta Castle, Old Havana, to the Torreon of San Lazaro, in Centro Habana in the early 1901. Later, works went on up to 23rd Street in Vedado neighborhood and G Street to end up in Almendares River.

This wall was a strategy to prevent the sea from coming inland during hurricane seasons. It goes along three municipalities: Old Havana, Centro Havana and Vedado. As time passed by Havana Malecon became more than just a simple wall. It's a symbol of the city, a source of inspiration for songs, love affairs, even political events and tragedies. People and visitors seat there every day as the wall were benches to see the sunset, feel the breeze at night, fall in love or simply have a colloquium with the Yoruba Goddess Yemayá. That's why it has been named the Big Havana Sofa. Some love jogging all along it while enjoying the magnificent view and it's still the ideal spot for fishermen in the city.

#### Espada Cemetery (1806)

It was the first graveyard the Village of San Cristobal de la Habana had after the prohibition to keep on burying inside the churches. It also was the first of its kind in Spanish America. It remained operational for 70 years but it had to stop due to population growth. It was located in the area of San Lázaro, Vapor, Espada and Aramburu streets. A remaining wall from that old construction can still be seen. The Colón Cemetery replaced it. This time a larger area was devoted for burials and beautiful marble sculptures, pantheons and fine tombs became part of the landscape as a sign of richness and devotion for such a sacred

place. It took 15 years to build it. Actually it's really near another cemetery, the Chinese Cemetery built for those who were Chinese or non catholic people.

#### Havana University

The Royal and Pontifical St. Hieronymus University of Havana was founded for the Dominican friars, on 1728. This facility nowadays it's a modern building that along with the old construction it's part of the University. The Musical Patrimony Department and other university departments have their offices there as well.

It's located in the Aróstegui Hill or Pyrotechnic Hill, on Vedado neighborhood. It was the second place assigned to build up this University in 1902, a bigger place than the former one in Old Havana.

The construction was finished on 1940. Several Faculties have their head offices there such as the Philosophy Faculty, History and Sociology Faculty, Mathematic and Computation Faculty and The Law Faculty where Fidel Castro Ruz studied. Visitors can have a spectacular welcoming by the Alma Mater sculpture on the top of the 88 stairway steps, the perfect location for graduation photos, important concerts and students celebrations. Also if you are there, you should visit the Felipe Poey Museum of Natural History and the Aula Magna full of past history up to present days.

#### **Hamel Alley**

The narrow two-block long alley between Aramburu and Hospital streets in Centro Habana is an Afro Cuban cultural project created by artist Salvador González. Visitors can live the atmosphere of ancestral religious beliefs, dances, drinks and traditional cuisine. The buildings are lined with brightly-colored paintings, murals, sculptures and objects, which depict rituals and deities. Also, rumba groups play here every Sunday.
